



Spotlight on defence

As a multidisciplinary engineering business, with capabilities across the infrastructure environment, VolkerWessels UK has worked increasingly for the Ministry of Defence through the Defence Infrastructure Organisation (DIO), to maintain, enhance and renew the UK's critical defence infrastructure.

VolkerStevin has continued to grow its expertise and capabilities to deliver works that support maritime operations for the Royal Navy. The business was appointed as one of the contractors on the DIO's 10 year Clyde Commercial Framework to deliver critical marine infrastructure upgrades at Faslane and Coulport in Scotland, and in 2019 work commenced on the Northern Ammunition Jetty at Glen Mallan. VolkerStevin also continued work throughout the year at HMNB Devonport in Plymouth to construct a new jetty providing fuelling facilities at Thanckes Oil Fuel Depot, and completed the final phase of the QEC aircraft carrier Base Porting Infrastructure programme to Victory Jetty at Portsmouth Naval Base.

Towards the end of the year, both VolkerStevin and VolkerFitzpatrick were awarded places on the Crown Commercial Service Construction and Associated Works framework, through which the UK Government is encouraging all public sector work to be procured, including DIO contracts.

VolkerFitzpatrick is delivering projects for the DIO at RAF and USAF air bases in the UK, using the expertise and experience of both its civils and building businesses.


At RAF Lakenheath, VolkerFitzpatrick is working in joint venture to deliver the infrastructure to ready the Suffolk base as the first permanent home in Europe of the US Air Force F-35 Fighter Jets. The project involves the construction of a new campus to house two squadrons of the fighter jets.

VolkerFitzpatrick is also working to resurface the runways at RAF Lossiemouth in Moray to prepare the base for the arrival of nine P-8A Poseidon Maritime Patrol Aircraft, due to arrive in the UK in 2020.

Our VolkerFitzpatrick building division has also been working with QinetiQ to construct a new National Maritime Systems Centre, in Portsdown Technology Park, Portsmouth, which once completed, will help transform the Technology Park into a UK Centre of Excellence for Maritime Mission Systems.
